

UNREACHABLE PLACES & AFFECTED PEOPLE

Siran Valley is one of the most severely affected areas of District Mansehra. As all bridges on Saran River and roads have been washed away by the cruel waters, the area remained cut off from rest of the district causing shortage of food and medicines. People were desperate to use contaminated water which diseased them dreadfully.



NCHD Mansehra was the first organization to arrive with relief in Siran Valley wrecked by floods. It worked in close coordination with District Administration and District Health Department to provide relief to the stranded people.

Human Development Support Unit (HDSU) -Mansehra mobilized medicines from local pharmacies, medical stores and philanthropists and arranged medical camps in Sum Elahi Mang & Basic Health Unit Panjool, Siran Valley. NCHD volunteers carried boxes of medicines on their shoulders and travelled long distances over mountains.



In a Medical Camp at Union Council Office Sum Elahi mang, three Doctors and two technicians provided treatment to 370 patients and distributed medicines worth Rs. 155,000. While 640 poor flood victims were provided with treatment at Panjool. Union Council Sacchan distributed free medicines worth Rs. 185,000.



The flood affected community, DCO Mansehra and EDO health appreciated NCHD's efforts for providing medical support and relief to the flood affectees at their door step.
