A Kalam resident of 20 years of age, wounded in his leg, was brought to NCHD Rubicon Medical Camp through Helicopter service. After receiving first aid, the doctor advised him to consult an Orthopedic Surgeon.

NCHD Swat staff collected donations for the wounded young man and the Pak army shifted the patient to Peshawar through Helicopter service for treatment on the request of DGM Swat, from where he left for Karachi to his relatives.



The wounded youth telephoned DGM Swat a few days later and thanked NCHD Swat team for their support in time of distress. He is well on his way towards recovery.
